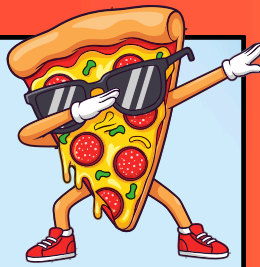

Parents are not permitted to park and drop off children in this area.

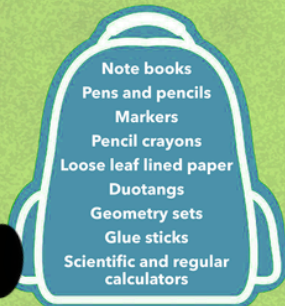
