- Label your baking if it is catered to certain dietary needs (eg. gluten free or dairy free).
- Label containers and reusable bags so they can be given back to the students.
- Cookies, brownies, squares, etc. need to be **individually packaged** (eg. Ziploc bags, plastic wrap) for safe food handling and distribution.

The order deadline is five days before the lunch date (Saturdays for Friday lunches). No refunds are available. If your child is absent on a hot lunch date, you may come and pick the lunch up at noon or donate it to the school to feed a child in need.


